How to earn the map points (25 points)

- Map theme is coherent and consistent throughout, including connection to overall name, purpose
 (presented as a slice of time), plus illustration style and symbols; it's also presented in a visually
 dynamic manner and your section blends with the others (10 points)
- Each individual section uses at least 10 different symbols, with at least five of those also found on other sections of this map; your section tells your part of the story somehow in a significant way; all of those symbols must be explained clearly in the map key, which must be included on the map (5 points)
- Craftsmanship, how carefully and artistically this is constructed and integrated into a whole, following the guidelines presented in the Life Map assignment guide (10 points)
- Captain leads the team (and presents the map to the rest of the class); 5 extra credit points
