Assignments:

Translate your memorized text into three forms: 1. Logographic (language through pictures, such as Chinese or Egyptian hieroglyphics), 2. Syllabic (symbols represent syllables, or sequences of speech sounds, such as Cherokee or Thai or Tibetan), 3. Alphabetic (other than English; ie into Spanish, French, German). Then write a one-page paper on that process (single spaced, 10-point type) about the choices you made, the troubles you had, the parts you found interesting, etc., reflecting on the Biguenet & Schulte piece. Also include a translation key for each of the languages you used. (25 points)
